



DO YOU KNOW WHO KENT HOVIND IS?

If you are not aware of who this man is, he is a Baptist minister who has been in prison for the past 8 years, and faces another possible 100 years.

WHY SHOULD YOU KNOW WHO HE IS?

Simply for the fact that he faces another 100 years in prison after he has already served his time. Whether you feel he was deserving of his sentence or not, does he deserve more time in prison? I appeal to your conscience, and to you to take some of your valuable time to judge for yourself whether this is just.

WHAT CHARGES IS HE CURRENTLY FACING?

Our friend George Lujack writes:

On February 9, 2015, Hovind is scheduled to begin a new trial, for six counts of mail fraud and criminal contempt charges.

Hovind is now facing another 20-year prison sentence upon completion of his 10-year prison sentence. And what are these new charges for? The latest indictment accuses Hovind of "willfully, knowingly, and with intent to defraud, devise and intend to devise a scheme to defraud the United States" through "a Claim of Lien Affidavit of Obligation with attachments" and "four Memoranda of Lis Pendens."

In layman's terms, Hovind is being charged for using the prison mail system (fraudulently) to appeal his previous 58-felony count conviction (contempt).

JUSTICE?

There are murderers, rapists, thieves, and the like, who have actually caused physical and emotional harm on the People of the U.S., who have served less time than this Baptist minister who was exercising his religion in promoting Young Earth Creationism and preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Is this right? If you do judge him as a criminal, Is tax crime worthy of such punishment? Is it fit in this case simply because the man preaches things that are not popular?

Al Sharpton owes 4.5 million in back taxes and visits the Whitehouse over 40 times and Kent Hovind gets sent to prison, and is now facing life in prison. We need you to expose this injustice.

WHY IS THIS IS IMPORTANT TO YOU?

Simply because you are a citizen of a nation, a Republic, that was founded upon a Constitution, and a Bill of Rights, and the principles of liberty to protect you from cruel and unusual punishment that a tyrannical government may seek to punish you with should they decide to make a special example out of you. Simply because our nation's fate depends upon its sons and daughters who will do their part in ensuring justice and liberty for all, and equity in judgment.

Dear reader, we simply ask you to consider for a moment, if this were your brother, father, or grandfather, would you not want to let others know about him being imprisoned for 10 years, and now possibly life, over TAX CRIME? How can we in good conscience stand by and watch this happen in silence?

SO WHAT WAS HE CONVICTED OF?

You should and must do your own research, which really doesn't take that much effort on your part, to come to your own conclusions, but to give you a good idea, and a good starting point.... Our friend George Lujack put it nicely in his article that he wrote for Cowger Nation.

1. Twelve counts of willful failure to withhold federal income taxes and FICA taxes from his employee's wages.

Hovind's defense: He is a tax-exempt minister, not an employer of a business.

Those who worked for him were either private contractors or were those assisting with his ministry. They were not his employees, but were either private businesses that he hired as a customer or co-workers for his ministry that were compensated accordingly.

2. Forty-five counts of structuring transactions to evade IRS reporting requirements.

Hovind's defense: To avoid unnecessary IRS inquires, he was advised to make withdrawals – of his own money – from his own accounts, in amounts of less than \$10,000. RICO laws were enacted to impede the ability of organized crime and drug cartels from using the American banking system to make large deposits and withdrawals of cash. It is not, nor should it be, a crime for a ministry to withdraw its own cash as funding needs of the ministry arise.

3. One count of corruptly endeavoring to obstruct and impede the administration of the internal revenue laws.

Hovind's defense: The only so-called "threat" Hovind made was that on a radio program when he prayed for an IRS agent investigating him.

PLEASE JUDGE FOR YOURSELF

A man could possibly spend the rest of his life in prison simply for not obeying some tax laws, and allegedly trying to defraud our government of money. Now consider all the wasteful government spending that goes on, and consider nobody is imprisoned for life for the billions and trillions of our own hard earned tax money the government has wasted. Is that justice for all? Is that equity? The amount of money the IRS claims Kent owes is NOTHING in comparison.

The ironic thing is that keeping Kent in prison is actually costing us tax payers MORE than if he were free to work to pay back the taxes that he allegedly owes. Yet does the government REALLY care about tax revenue here? One has to wonder.
